

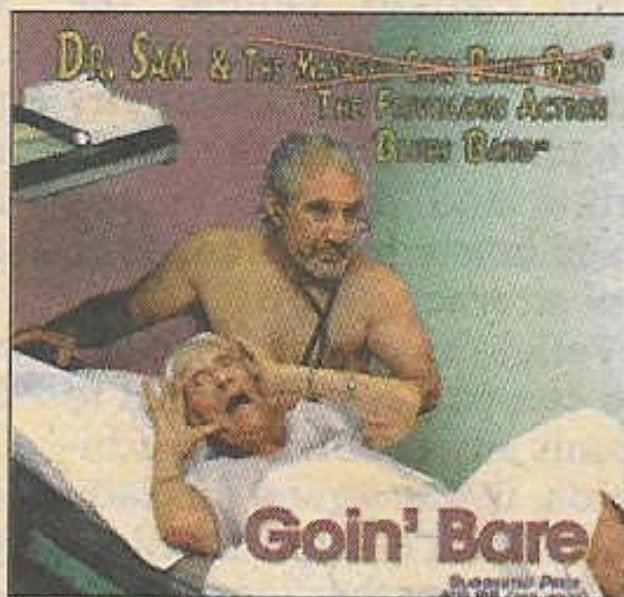
# Eye surgeon bares all for music career
